Further to our letter dated 15<sup>th</sup> April 2020, we would like to update you on our current operational status.

As a consequence of measures taken by the Government of India to stem the spread of the COVID-19 virus, the Prime Minister declared that the complete lockdown of the Country would be extended to 17<sup>th</sup> May 2020.

Our plant in Pune will be completely shut down at this time as Pune has been classified as a “Red Zone” due to the high number of positive cases of COVID-19.

Our Bangalore plant will be able to operate during this period at an optimum of 20% of its total strength.

As there are no flights operating in and out of the Country, the logistics is a major challenge, and it is difficult to make shipments to our customers both domestic and export. As and when the situation improves, we will be able to effect deliveries.

We will try our level best and hope the Government gives us permission to operate our plants in both locations with increased levels of plant utilization and as and when this happens, we stand committed to keeping you updated in this dynamic and evolving situation.

We remain committed to our employee’s safety and health and will continue to take necessary measures and safety precautions while abiding to the Government’s guidelines.
